Note to the reader

The latest available consolidated trade data at EU level cover market developments until August 2022. Monthly figures can be compared with the previous month. Year-to-year change compares the cumulative trade since the beginning of the year with the same period in the previous year.

The trade figures are expressed in values, except when specifically mentioned. The unit value is the average price of products traded in the period concerned (trade value at the border divided by quantity registered).

HIGHLIGHTS: EU AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS BOOSTED IN AUGUST 2022, IMPROVING TRADE BALANCE

Both EU agri-food exports and imports climbed in August, in value terms. EU monthly trade flows reached their highest point for 2022, at EUR 35 billion. **EU trade balance** in August slightly improved compared to July, **at EUR 5.6 billion**, and is also the highest value in 2022.

EU **exports** reached **EUR 20.3 billion** in August 2022. This corresponds to a 6% increase compared to July 2022. Compared to August 2021, this is still 27% higher even if prices started to go up already at this period of 2021 for certain commodities. With the fresh 2022 harvest of wheat, EU export values increased significantly in particular to MENA region (+40% compared to August 2021) and sub-Saharan Africa (+80%).

EU **imports** expanded and reached **EUR 14.7 billion** in August 2022, a 3% increase compared to the previous month. EU maize imports have particularly increased in August 2022, following hot and dry conditions in the EU and reached 2.8 million t, mainly coming from Brazil and Ukraine.

EU AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS

EU EXPORTS TO MENA REGION CONTINUE TO INCREASE

In August 2022, EU agri-food exports increased (by 6% month-to-month) in value terms. The most important trade partners in August were the United Kingdom, the US and China. While monthly export value to the US remained stable, EU exports to China decreased (-3%) and the exports to the UK increased (+2%).

EU top export products to the US in August were wine (17% of EU agri-food exports, in value), spirits and liqueurs (15%) and cereal preparations (9%). In August, EU wine exports slightly recessed (-EUR 48.9 million compared to July), while spirits and liqueurs and cereal preparations increased by EUR 11.4 million and EUR 5 million, respectively.

Regarding trade with China in August 2022, the EU mainly exported pigmeat (mostly frozen meat and offal), cereal preparations and dairy products. Despite the general decline in 2022, exports of pigmeat in August reached EUR 321 million (EUR 293 million in August 2021).

Trade developments in January-August 2022

Compared to the same period in 2021, the most significant increases of EU exports were recorded for the UK (+EUR 4.4 billion), US (+EUR 3.4 billion) and Morocco (+EUR 1.2 billion). In total, the EU exported EUR 148 billion of agri-food products from January to August 2022. This corresponds to 75% of the value of total 2021 exports.


DYNAMIC EXPORTS OF CEREALS PREPARATIONS AND WHEAT

The biggest export values in August were for cereal preparations (EUR 1.7 billion), wheat (EUR 1.6 billion) and wine (EUR 1.4 billion).

EU exports of cereal preparations are going primarily to the United Kingdom, China and the United States. These countries represent close to 55% of the EU exports in cereals preparations. The EU also exports large amounts to the MENA region (11% of total volumes exported) and to sub-Saharan Africa (6%).

Large shares of EU wheat exports are going to the MENA region and to sub-Saharan Africa. In August only, 2 million tons of wheat reached the MENA region (48% of total EU wheat exports) and 1.5 million tons arrived in sub-Saharan Africa (34% of total EU wheat exports).

EU wine exports reached EUR 1.4 billion in August (-EUR 177 million compared to exports in July). Trade in August declined to almost all destinations month-to-month, but was still above the trade in August 2021 (+13%). Since the beginning of the year 2022, the EU exported EUR 11.4 billion of wine. North America is by far the largest importing region, totalling 36% of total EU exports. European neighbours of the EU (United Kingdom, Switzerland and Norway) account for 27% of EU exports.



EU AGRI-FOOD IMPORTS

SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE OF IMPORTS FROM UKRAINE

EU imports increased by 3% in August 2022 compared to previous month and reached EUR 14.7 billion. The EU mainly imported from Brazil (EUR 1.9 billion), the United Kingdom (EUR 1.3 billion) and Ukraine (EUR 1.1 billion).

EU imports from **Ukraine** increased by 19% in August compared to July, mainly due to increased imports of rapeseed (+469%) and wheat (+246%) in value terms. This was largely due to an increase in volumes imported in the EU (+300 thousand t of rapeseed and +112 thousand t of wheat). On the contrary, EU imports of sunflower seeds declined by 42% while sunflower oil imports increased mildly (+2%), suggesting a lower crushing margin over the month.

Imports from **Brazil** remained stable in August compared to July, in value terms. This is due to a sharp increase of maize and raw sugar imports (+144% and +249%, respectively), contrasted by a decrease for soya beans and juices (-58% and -16%, respectively).

Trade developments in January-August 2022


Total EU imports from January to August 2022 reached EUR 110.9 billion, corresponding to 85% of the annual imports in 2021. The biggest increase has been registered for Brazil (+EUR 4 billion), Ukraine (+EUR 2.8 billion) and the UK (+EUR 2.5 billion).

EU imports from **Türkiye** increased by 13% in the period January-August 2022 compared to previous year (in value terms). The biggest increase has been for tomatoes (+EUR 51 million), cereals preparations (+EUR 32 million) and plant fibres (+EUR 26 million). In volumes terms, wheat imports almost doubled while citrus, nuts and juices have significantly increased as well.

EU MAIZE IMPORTS BOOMED IN AUGUST

EU **maize** imports rose significantly in August. In volume terms, imports increased by 77% month-to-month to reach 2.8 million t. This increase is primarily due to the reduction of EU domestic production due to the drought all across the continent. The EU mainly imported from Brazil, Ukraine and Serbia, but also from the UK and Russia.

For **oilseed products**, the EU imported slightly less volumes of rapeseed in August compared to July, but with a significant increase of imports from Ukraine (and less from Australia and Canada). The EU imported significantly less sunflower (-41%) as well as less soya beans (-40%). Regarding oilseed meals, the EU imported in August more rapeseed and soya meals but slightly less sunflower meal.




FOCUS

EU trade with India in 2021 and in January-July 2022

India is one of the largest trade partner for EU. The EU and India, following the common strategy to deepen cooperation¹, have been continuing expanding their trade in agri-food market, aiming to gain sustainability in trading and economies. Global food security crisis was one of the issue India decided to tackle by promoting new ways of nutrition and intensive support of grain cultivation such as millets.

EU-INDIA agri-food trade state of play in 2021

The EU is a net importer in agri-food *vis-à-vis* India. In 2021, the most exported goods to India were plant fibers (EUR 96 million). Dairy products (mainly lactose) and fruit and nuts (mostly apple and pears) completed the top three with EUR 66 million and EUR 63 million. On the import side, the most imported products are coffee, tea, cocoa and spices (EUR 521 million). Rice is also a significant product imported from India (EUR 166 million) as well as raw tobacco (EUR 161 million). In 2021, soya meal imports were significantly up in value terms (EUR 324 million, +685% compared to 2020).



Trade in January-August 2022

EU Exports. During the first 8 months in 2022, EU exports to India increased substantially compared to 2021 – from EUR 500 million to EUR 761 million. In January-August 2022, the highest export values were vegetable oils (+EUR 83.5 million). The EU supplied to India 63 thousand tons of oils, which is almost four times higher than in 2021. Particularly, the EU exported soya oil (30 thousand tons) and sunflower oil (33 thousand tons). On the contrary, there was a significant drop in the amount of cereals exported to India in 2022 (-10 thousand tons).

EU Imports. During this period in 2022, imports depicted an increasing trend between the EU and India (from EUR 2 billion to EUR 2.5 billion). This was mainly due to an increased import value for coffee (+EUR 123 million, with increased import volumes), margarine and other oils (+EUR 82 million) and mixed food preparations (+EUR 61 million). On the contrary, the import of soya cakes (-367 thousand tons) and soya seeds (-6 thousand tons) have dropped in this period in 2022. The decrease in EU imports of non-edible products particularly plant fibres (e.g. cotton, jute plants) is significant (-16.7 thousand tons) as well, though the value of its import has peaked from EUR 89.5 million to EUR 131.1 million.
