expand these to all members, thus increasing the collaborative strength of the European University.







4-week mobility for research staff – **24 grants per year**

12-week mobility for research staff – 8 grants per year

4-week mobility for research and postgraduate students – **24 grants per year**

A total of 72 students and 96 research staff mobility activities

- 80 Short Advanced Programmes
 More than 1,100 students and 160 academic staff mobility activities
- RUN-EU collaborative European degrees
 24 double degrees and 3 joint degrees
 128 student mobility grants and 152 staff mobility for teaching and exploratory missions;
- The annual student week (organized during the RUN-EU General Assembly)
 120 students from the eight HEIs in each of the three years of the project total 315 student mobility activities
- Administrative and project management 158 staff mobility activities

In summary, 1,615 students and 686 academic and administrative staff members

The alliance will develop a **tailored and long-term structure for cooperation**, based on the existing cooperation between the partners, with the **clear ambition to deepen it** within a ten-year horizon.

The proposal shows **high levels of ambition and innovation**, particularly in terms of the proposed new structures in the educational area.

The proposal shows **a strong and genuine commitment to European goals** of multilingualism, mobility, social inclusion, multiculturalism, and regional engagement.



Think as a European University

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Thereby, the existing, already extensive cooperation between the alliance members will be intensified and expanded.

The distribution of responsibilities, tasks and active roles of the RUN-EU alliance members is clear and appropriate (...). However there seems to be is an inconsistency between the statement that one of the partners will co-lead a work package despite the fact that its role is not explained in this specific package.


A collective governance structure is proposed.

The **risk analysis is realistic but further explanations** in some points are needed.

The proposal foresees detailed budgeting and financial controlling to ensure that all activities will be carried out within the planned budget.

The financial rationality and quality monitoring are also the subject of carefully designed procedures based on quantitative and qualitative indicators. However, the formulation of some indicators is a little general.














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
