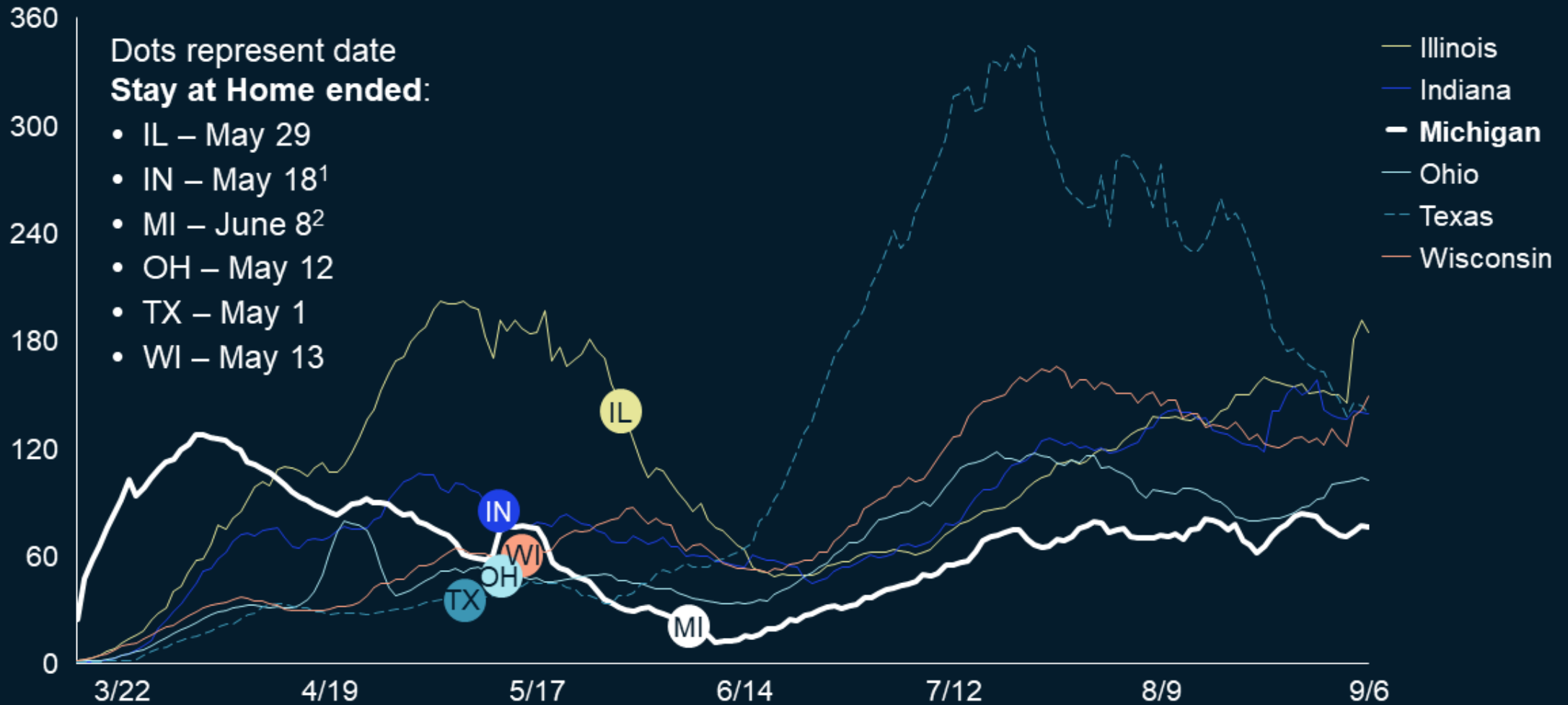

COVID-19 PANDEMIC.**

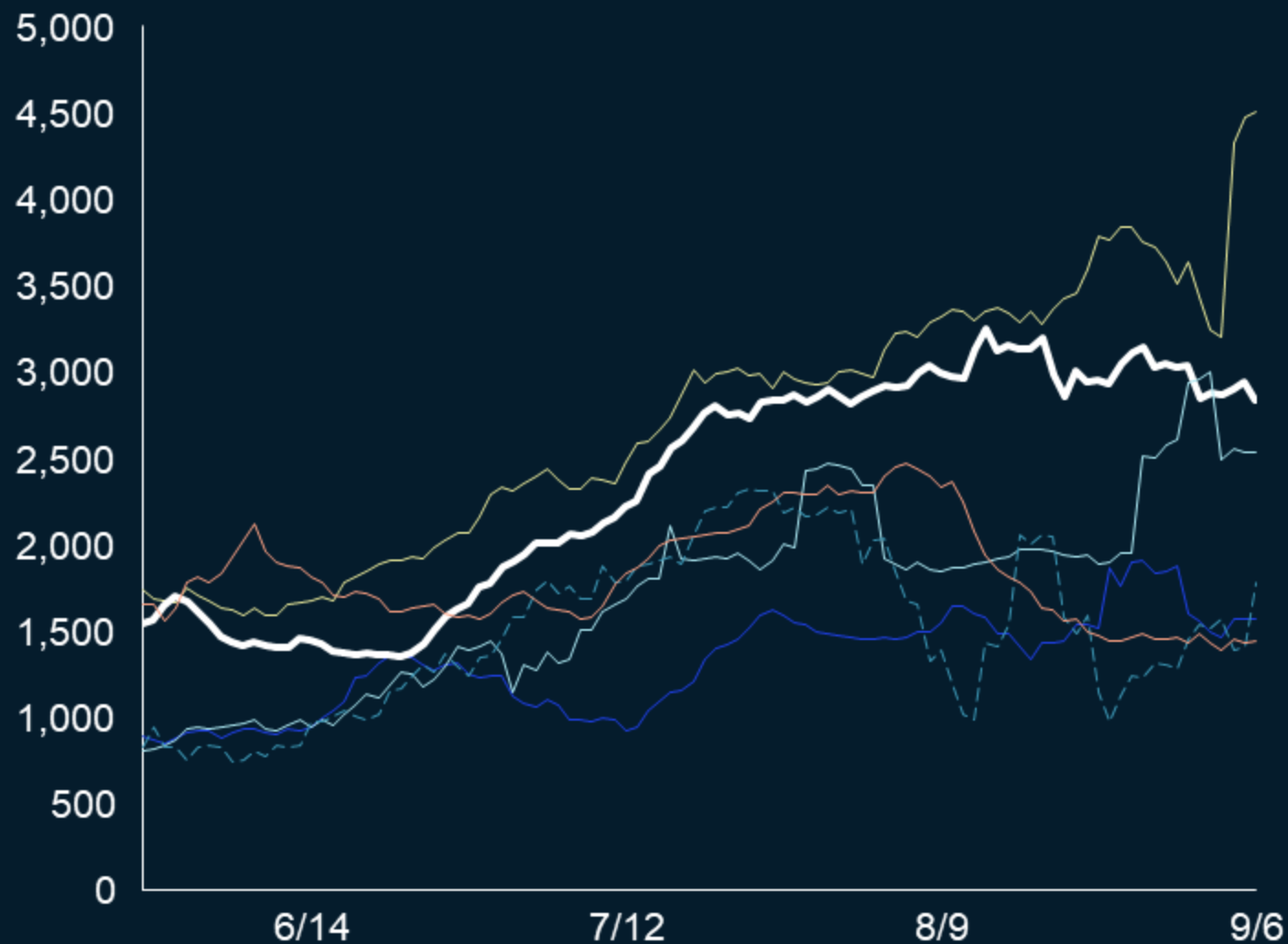
Daily cases per million people, by reported date (Seven day rolling average)

Michigan testing increased rapidly over the summer, regularly reaching 30K total daily tests (3,000 per million residents)
