

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Overview CAP from 2023




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Budget distribution DE 2023-2027

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New accents in the planned funding concept of the 2nd pillar in Baden-Wurttemberg

- ✓ Maintaining the **competitiveness** of farms
- ✓ Strengthening **regional value chains**
- ✓ Strengthening environmental and climate-related measures with a focus on promoting **biodiversity** and **reducing chemical-synthetic plant protection** (Biodiversity Strengthening Act)
- ✓ Expansion of **organic agriculture** (objective: 30 to 40 % on the land by 2030)
- ✓ Contribution of agriculture to **climate protection** and adaptation of agriculture to climate change (*new FAKT - Agri-environment, climate protection and animal welfare - measures, crop insurance*)
- ✓ Strengthening **animal welfare / future-oriented livestock farming** (*new “FAKT” measures, changes in AFP - Agricultural investment promotion programme*)
- ✓ Strengthening **knowledge transfer** and **knowledge exchange** (new measures for further training)



8. Landscape Management Directive (LPR) (*Measure of the Environment Ministry*)
9. Sustainable Forest Management (NWW)



Agri Environmental and Climate Measures (AECM) funding payments in Baden-Wurttemberg from 2023

Programme for agri-environment and climate protection and animal welfare (FAKT II)

- A. Environmentally conscious farm management**
 - B. Preservation and maintenance of the cultural landscape and specially protected grassland habitats**
 - C. Safeguarding particularly endangered uses and animal breeds that are particularly important for the landscape**
 - D. Organic farming / renunciation of chem.-synth. plant protection products and fertilizers on the farm**
 - E. Environmentally friendly plant production and use of biological/biotechnical measures**
 - F. Voluntary measures for water and erosion protection**
 - G. Particularly animal-friendly husbandry practices – animal welfare**
- on total about 40 measures
 - subsidies are granted per unit (hectares, trees, number of animals)

Advisory funding

Advisory Module

- offered in Baden-Wurttemberg since 2015
- also in the new GAP funding period

What is the aim of the measure?

- Qualification and improvement of entrepreneurial and ecological competences

What is supported?

- Advisory services for agricultural enterprises on the basis of defined advisory modules

Who is supported?

- Independent advisory organisations selected through a tendering procedure and awarded a service concession.

Coverage (old CAP funding period, years 2020/21/22)

- Around 7,000 modules per year, around 950 € per module



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Innovative Measures for Women in Rural Areas (IMF)



Support measures (beginning mid-2023):

a) Promotion of investments in the development of non-agricultural enterprises of women in rural areas

→ in the CAP-SP under EL-0412 "Promotion of investments in the development of non-agricultural enterprises in rural areas" (pp.1378-1386).

b) Qualification and coaching measures

Promotion of target group-specific tailor-made training measures for women

→ in the GAP-SP under EL-0802 "Qualification, demonstration activities and knowledge exchange" (pp.1483-1503)

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conclusions and outlook

experience made during the first year of new CAP period:

- greater need for coordination between state and federal government
- uncertainty: how will the programmes/interventions be accepted by the beneficiaries?
- less freedom for design of agri environment measures (AECM), because of eco schemes

conclusions:

- **regional** programming of (environmental) measures is much better accepted by the farmers
- urgent need for achieving administrative simplifications
